
This bold promise—making the Bible accessible to all people—animates everything we do at American Bible Society.

Rivers of Living Water

You Gave an Island Tribe in the Philippines Life-Giving Access to God's Word

Subanen means “people of the river.”

Until recently, this indigenous people group in the mountains of the Philippines worshiped the river rather than the God who made the river.

“Most of them are pagans,” explains one pastor in the region. “They worship the woods, the river, the stones.”

But God, in his mercy, had a different destiny mapped out for the Subanen people—calling them to the living water of his Word.



The Subanen tribe used to worship the river. Then they met Jesus.

First came the clear proclamation of the gospel. Local missionaries like Pastor Pablito ascended the mountain to teach the Subanen people about Jesus. Step by step, he climbed those mountain paths—often alone—driven by obedience to Christ and love for the lost.

“When I started, the church was not yet here,” he recalls. “I had to do one-on-one evangelism.”

Then came a church building. New believers donated materials and land so their community of faith could gather and worship the one true God. But even with a pastor, a building, and a growing church, the Subanen people were missing something vital.

“It was very hard because we had no Bibles,” explains Pastor Pablito.

This was no minor inconvenience. Without daily access to God’s Word, new believers in this remote mountain

community were at risk of slipping back into false teaching and idol worship. Their faith was young and fragile, and they longed for spiritual nourishment to help them grow.

You helped them replace their idols with Bibles.

But thanks to you, this remote island community no longer lives in Bible poverty. Your generosity placed the truth of Scripture directly in their hands—and hearts—through print, audio, and video Bibles in their heart language of Subanen.

What a difference this makes for people who only recently met Jesus and yearn to walk with him daily! Because of you, they can open their Bibles anytime, anywhere, and encounter God in his Word yet again.

“Now each member has their own copy,” celebrates Pastor Pablito. “They can read anytime they want.” Hearing God’s voice in Subanen reminds minority language speakers that God sees them, knows them, and loves them.

“When I heard the Bible in my own language, I felt very happy inside,” says a Bible recipient named Vilma. Tears fill Vilma’s eyes as she remembers how God’s Word comforts her amid life’s many heartaches. “It made me realize even our tribe can get help. . . . God never turns his back on me.”

With God’s Word in a language and format they clearly understand, the Subanen people can now see God at work in their daily lives.

For one Bible recipient named Melina, Scripture provides daily encouragement in the fields where she works. “As a farmer, I resonated with the Parable of the Sower,” she says. “When you sow with Jesus, your harvest will be good!”

Another Bible recipient named Nilson shares how the voice of Jesus in the Sermon on the Mount calms his troubled heart. “Before, my mind was troubled. I always worried about what we would eat,” Nilson shares. “Now I have peace of mind through God’s Word. . . . If we seek God first and his righteousness, all things will be provided.”



Because of you, their lives and eternities will never be the same.

Nearly every Subanen Bible recipient can describe how the Bible has transformed their beliefs and behaviors. Vices like gambling and gossip have been exchanged for a life-giving relationship with Jesus. Where idols once stood, open Bibles now rest.

“The change in my life began when I started reading the Bible,” says one new believer named Arlene. “Now God will be the center of our lives.”

Because of your faithfulness, a people who once worshiped creation now hold the Creator’s Word in their own hands. Heaven rejoices—and so do the Subanen, holding their Bibles close.

“Thank you for these copies of the Bible in our own tribal language of Subanen,” says Pastor Pablito. “With these materials, we now have access to know God’s Word.”



Sadness Turned to Sunlight

*You Helped a Struggling Teen
Experience the Life-Changing
Love of Jesus*

“I felt like I was stuck.”

Like millions of U.S. teenagers, Leila struggled with anxiety, depression, and loneliness. Every day felt heavy—like her smile was just a mask. Even in a world more connected than ever, Leila felt painfully alone.

“Social media adds to anxiety and depression,” Leila says. “We compare ourselves to others. You only see a glimpse of someone’s life. You don’t see what’s going on behind closed doors.”



You carried the light of God's Word into the darkness of Leila's depression.

But caring friends like you refused to stand by as Leila struggled alone.

You know that God's Word can pierce even the deepest darkness and change any circumstance. So, through your prayers and generous giving, you stepped into Leila's story right when she needed it most.

Through a Restoring Hope Bible and small group—made possible by you—Leila discovered that God saw her pain, loved her deeply, and could bring healing to her heart. Light began to break through Leila's darkness.

In the Bible, Leila experienced the healing love of her heavenly Father.



In a supportive Christian community, Leila discovered she wasn't alone. "Being in a room with people who are actually going through similar things—I know I can overcome what I'm going through, because they can do the same," she says.

It was so much more than a therapy session. It was a life-changing encounter with God in the Bible.

"The program definitely made me look at God as my Father instead of just this being in the sky," she says. "Now I can talk to God about how I'm feeling, and he

will respond back! God is right by my side."

That's the miracle your generosity makes possible. Young people are forging a relationship with a heavenly Father who listens, loves, and heals.


Now Leila lives her life anchored in the power of Christ.

Thank you for bringing the light of Christ to the next generation. 





“I’ve met people who’ve been through things like I have. We talk about the Bible and about life. It’s helped me heal.”



From Carolina to Cambodia



Elevation Church Outreach Partnership Director John Nichols shares how his church in North Carolina is advancing God's Word around the world.




Q: What led Elevation Church to partner with American Bible Society?

A: If someone is living without access to Scripture, our call as believers in Christ is to help get it to them—whether through audio, print, or other formats. We seek to partner with organizations that do that with

consistency, integrity, accountability, and a truly global reach. American Bible Society checks all those boxes for us. I've been amazed by their breadth and creativity. I love that they don't limit themselves to one method or format. When a person at our church gives faithfully and then sees the gospel being shared around the world, that builds faith! It's a beautiful partnership.

Q: What does stewardship mean to you and your team?

A: We approach stewardship with deep honor, humility, and accountability. We want everyone to know that when they give and trust the storehouse of Elevation Church, those resources are being sown into good soil. No matter who you are—a young adult, a married couple, a student—your giving matters. It's a big deal, and we want to steward it well. We want to show that we're reaching the ends of the earth, meeting people's needs, and changing lives—now and for generations to come.



Q: Tell us about the Bible translation project your church sponsored this year.

A: As we planned for 2025, we wanted to focus on evangelism. While that's something every church should be doing, we wanted to emphasize it through a Bible translation project. The one that stood out to us was with the Kravet people in northeastern Cambodia—a community of about 8,000 people living in the hills. Until now, they've only shared stories of God through word of mouth. It's been really exciting to see the progress. As each book of the Bible is translated, it's printed and shared with the local church leaders, who are already using it. By 2027, the entire New Testament will be completed, beautifully bound, and in the hands of the Kravet people. It's going to be transformative.

Q: What spiritual impact do you hope to see through your giving?

A: I can't imagine living in a place where I don't have access to God's Word. I remember seeing a project like this come to completion years ago—watching mothers, fathers, and elders receive Scripture in their own language for the first time. It's emotional. It's hard not to cry with joy. This people group will now have the Word of God in their heart language for generations to come. One day, we will get to celebrate with them and with the angels in heaven! It's incredible to share with our church: "Your giving helped make this possible." I'm so thankful to God that we get to be a part of this. How could we not say yes?

Q: If Elevation Church wrote a letter to the Kravet Church, what would you say?

A: God absolutely loves you. He formed you. He created you. You have value. He sees your smiles. He sees your tears. And he knows that you matter in this world that he created. You matter to him forever. May this Word of God—his love letter to you—be a precious gift to you. Treasure it each day, knowing it reveals his heart. We're honored and grateful to have played a small part in sharing his love with you. We believe the best days are ahead as you experience God in a deeper, more personal way through his Word.







A Word on Stewardship

Dear Friends,

Stewardship is one of our highest responsibilities here at American Bible Society. Your *trust* as a partner in the Great Commission is more precious to us than any financial donation.

That's why our finances are carefully reviewed through annual independent audits and ongoing internal audits—all within compliance of GAAP and IRS standards.

To maximize the impact of your giving, we keep costs low. This year, 75% of every dollar spent went directly to Bible ministry—split evenly between domestic and international efforts. This ratio between our program and overhead expenses meets or exceeds industry benchmarks.

We carry no debt, and our long-term investment fund—built by supporters over two centuries—provides stability in an uncertain economy. It also allows us to send even more of your God-given resources directly into the mission field.

For every \$1.00 given through donations and Scripture sales, we invested \$1.52 into life-changing Bible ministry! We're blessed to invest alongside you to increase the impact of every gift.

In all these things, we give thanks and glory to God, who abundantly provides all that we need. Thank you for trusting him with *your* finances and for choosing to invest in a mission that we know “will not return void.”
