This letter was written to Titus, an early leader in the church. Originally it included special instructions for the different groups within in the church in Crete. But it is very relevant for today's Christians as well.

The letter encourages Titus to continue teaching the truth about the faith and to instruct people on living their lives as God wants. Apparently, some of the people in the churches in Crete were trying to fool some of the followers by teaching false things.

Study Questions

- What do you think "everything is pure for the pure in heart" (1.15) means? How does this statement affect you?
- 3. According to the author of Titus, how did God show his kindness? (2.11-14; 3.4-7).
- 4. Why was Titus instructed to remind the people in his care to obey the government rulers and authorities? (3.1) What might have been the consequences if they were rebellious? What do you think of this advice?

- Use with people who don't know much about the Bible. Maybe they are new Christians or people who are uncertain about what the Bible is about. These sheets can act as a primer to basic Bible knowledge about the contents of each book and why it was written.
- Use during family time with your teens and pre-teens as a reinforcement to the lessons learned in church. While your son or daughter may already think that they're adults, these study sheets can help you help them transition into adulthood with grace and compassion.
- Finally, use with your neighbors, co-workers, friends and loved ones who have expressed an interest in the Bible. Form a small in home group and increase your awareness of what the Scriptures are saying. Try to develop bonds that will help each of you remain faithful to God and his Word.
