1. My son was Lamech and my grandson was Noah. People often use my name when they describe things that are considered "old." (Genesis 5:25-29)
2. My wife had twins. I was blind in later years, and one of them tricked me. (Genesis 25:19-22; 27:1-19)
3. I am the great-grandfather of King David. (Ruth 4:13,16,17)
4. I was unable to speak because I did not believe the angel who told me that my wife and I would have a baby. (Luke 1:13, 18-20)
5. God promised me that he would bless me and that my descendants would become a great nation. (Genesis 12:2)
6. My two sons, James and John, were disciples of Jesus. (Matthew 10:2)
7. My son was a priest-in-training at the temple at a young age. One night while sleeping, he heard the voice of God. (1 Samuel 1:19-21; 3:1-4)
8. My father's disobedience to the prophet Moses caused my death during the last plague of Egypt. (Exodus 11:4-6; 29)
9. After having the time of his life and wasting his money, my son was forced to eat animal food, and then return home to say he was sorry. (Luke 15:11-21)
10. I made a vow to God that I would sacrifice whoever first came out to meet me if I defeated the Ammonites. I won and my daughter was the first person I saw. (Judges 11:29-35).
11. My son was the wisest man around. He was quite rich but he found favor with God. (2 Chronicles 1:1-12)
12. My son did everything I asked him to. When he was being baptized, I told those around that I was pleased with him. (Luke 3:21,22)
