"How could you betray me with a kiss?"



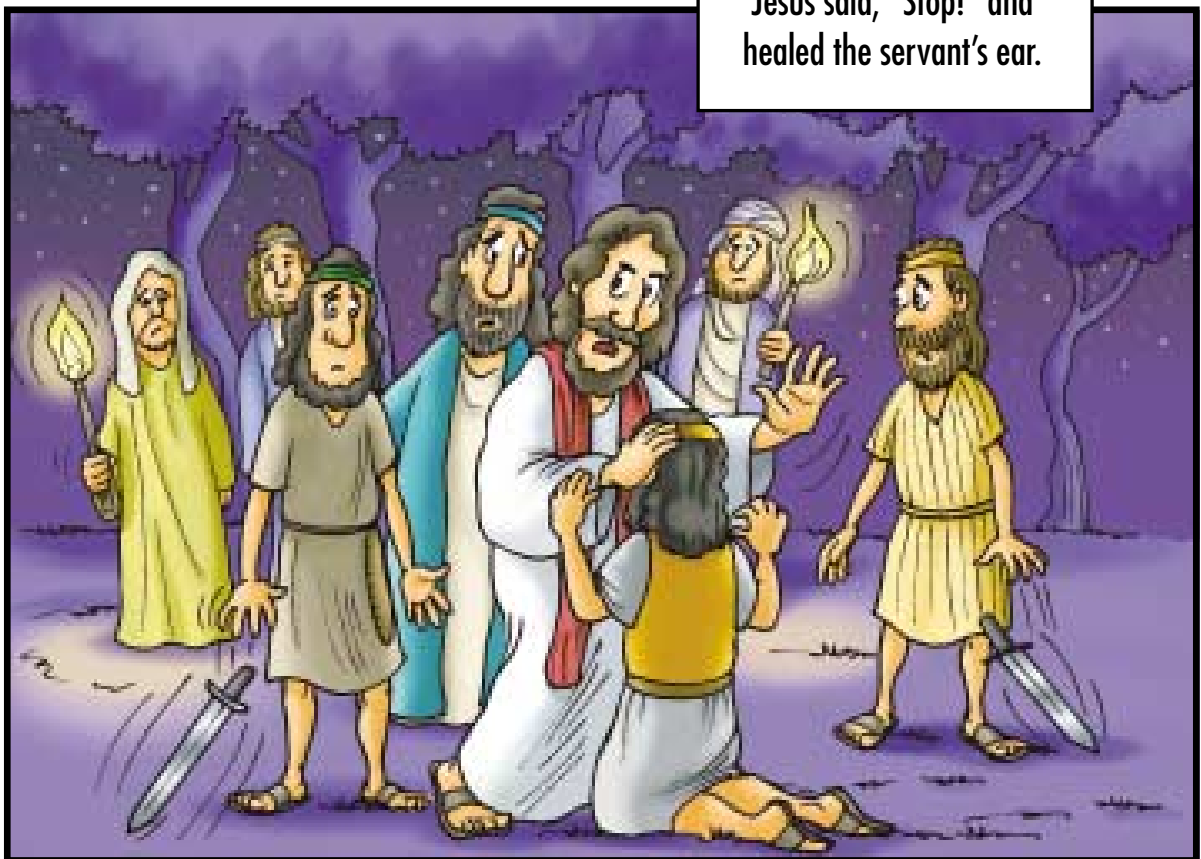
"Lord, we will defend you."



A disciple cut off the ear of a servant.



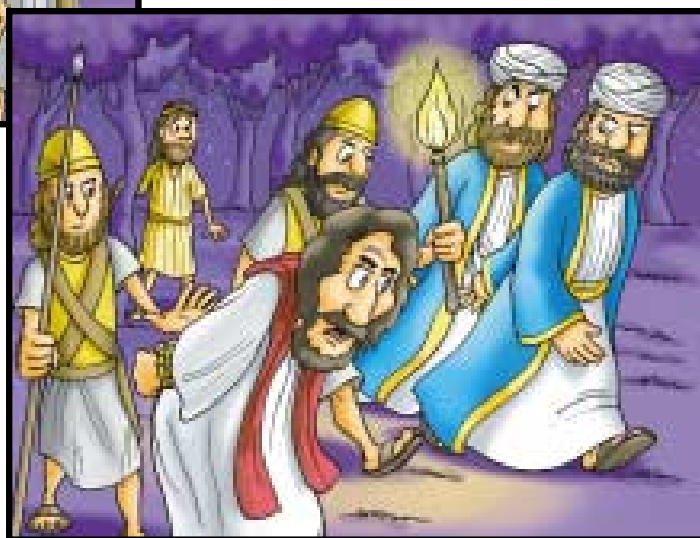
Jesus said, "Stop!" and healed the servant's ear.
