Armed Services Ministry in collaboration with Veteran Affairs (VA) chaplain consultants developed the God Understands series: A program created to provide healing, hope and comfort to Veterans dealing with post-traumatic stress disorder and the spiritual, physical and emotional brokenness brought on by active duty service.

Based on the Spiritual Injury Scale used by VA chaplains, real life situations about Veterans are shared to help identify spiritual injuries that often lead to feelings of uncertainty. Themed topics such as anger, grief, hopelessness, guilt, fear of death, a sense that life is unfair, that life is meaningless are explored in combination with God's Word.

There is a common human thread that flows through our frailties, our weaknesses, our heartaches and our sufferings — and a common thread of hope that so many have found through prayer and Scripture.
